Recycling Tips

By recycling regularly, you can help reduce the need for landfills, lower disposal costs, reduce pollution and conserve natural resources. Here's a list of items you can recycle in your Blue Cart. You might be surprised!

Do Recycle:

- Glass jars and bottles
- Aluminum cans
- Milk, juice cartons, and waxy cardboard (aseptic) containers
- Newspapers and inserts
- Cereal boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.
- Junk mail
- Paper bags
- Tin or steel cans
- Cardboard (flatten all boxes)
- Telephone books
- Magazines and catalogs
- Office paper and file folders

Don't Recycle:

- Garbage
- Clothing
- Plastic grocery bags
- Styrofoam
- Yard waste
- Food waste
- Ceramics or dishes
- Motor oil containers
- Electronics
- Light bulbs, window glass or mirrors
- Hazardous waste containers
- Construction waste
